Words of Counsel to the Catholics of Newport.

In giving a printed report to the Catholics of this parish of the subscribers' names and the amount subscribed, I deem it of much importance to invite their attention to certain evils which, I regret to say, attracted my attention during the visitation of the parish.

ABSENCE FROM MASS.

There is a considerable number of men who are extremely careless in attending to their duties on Sundays. The third commandment emphatically prescribes the sanctification of the Lord's day, and it is painfully evident that families, whose parents neglect or despise this commandment, lose all reverence for the Author of their being, invade the laws on which society is founded, and inflict disgrace not only on themselves and the neighborhood which is cursed with their presence, but likewise on the church in which they were baptized and made children of the living God.

Many fathers lament the waywardness of their sons and daughters, when in truth they are themselves the cause of the misery they deplore. Had they been more obedient to the command of God, expressed by the voice of His church, they would have been spared the bitter pang of sorrow and the deadly arrow of remorse. God chastises their disobedience and negligence by permitting their sons and daughters to abuse their liberty, and often, alas! to

die inglorious and dishonored. Many of the evils which we have to deplore are unquestionably to be attributed to the fatal example of an irreligious, blustering parent. It is hoped, henceforth, that the prudent father, who loves his child and hopes to see him pursue a useful and honorable career, will remember those beautiful words of our divine Redeemer, "Seek first the Kingdom of God," etc., and we may rest assured that peace and order will be the result.

DRUNKENNESS.

Another evil which threatens to undermine the health, the peace, and the social character of the family, is the vice of drunkenness. This monster of iniquity has been in the past, as it is in the present, the destroyer of youth, the enemy of the family, and the herald of physical and moral degeneracy to the future generation. A drunken, dissipated father will, unless God derogates by a miracle from natural laws, give being to a posterity weak and feeble, worthless and immoral, a burden to themselves, and too often a scourge to the city where they reside. Like begets like, and the "effect is never stronger than the cause." To crush and stamp out this vice of drunkenness should be the fixed and determined aim of every individual in society who is not a drunkard himself. The virtuous must hate the vice that debases man below the brute creation; the patriot must hate the vice that threatens to reduce his countrymen to the condition of feeble idiots or nervous and unbalanced men; the avaricious even should hate this vice which wages war on his purse in taxation for prisons for the young and asylums for the weak. All should unite to crush out this vice, and if necessary, to punish it with rigor. Imprisonment, hard labor, deprivation of civil rights, would not be too severe for the drunkard who can not be corrected by milder methods. But the wretch who dispenses to young children the poisoned cup of intoxica-

ting drink, thereby impairing their youthful intellects, and sowing, in the moring of their existence, the seed of moral and mental decay, I would hold more guilty than the assassin, for while the latter only strikes at one, the other prepares death for hundreds of innocents, and not satisfied with brutalizing every generous and noble instinct, opens the gate leading to the abyss, and cold, treacherous and impassive, invites them onward to a sad and dreadful eternity. Now, Catholics of Newport, are you aware of such a destroyer in your midst? And if you are, are you justified in tolerating him to bring disgrace on your children and sorrow and dismay on your aged years? You are not justified. There yet remain some laws made by old people of the olden times, and these, if enforced, would protect you from a sorrow worse than death. Enforced they would and should be, if it were once discovered that the people demanded a strict administration of justice for the common weal. The cure of the evil rests with yourselves, and may the Almighty in his mercy impart to you the light necessary to protect yourselves and families from the threatened dangers.

MARRIAGE.

It is contrary to the moral well being of society that individuals, pretending to belong to the Catholic church, should retain in their households persons of doubtful reputation, and slyly wink at rumors confirming their marriage in places where God alone knows where. If such persons were married in the Catholic church, they must have spoken falsely to the officiating priest who performed the ceremony, and who could not act in his sacerdotal character without obtaining the consent of their lawful pastor. Now, if they obtained *his* consent, there is no reason whatever to be ambiguous in the matter and thus expose themselves to the suspicion alike of the just and

the unjust. Marriages between Catholics should be in accordance with the rules of the church which blesses their union, and by the sacraments of Jesus Christ enables them to live in mutual fidelity and love.

In the observance of these counsels which are taken from the words of the divine Author of Christianity, the security, the happiness and the social well-being of the Catholics of Newport are placed. Compliance with these will render the people, not merely theoretical, but practical Catholics, devout children of that church that founded nations and conducted them to maturity; that presided at the birth of governments, and taught them how to demand obedience; that braved the *isms* of eighteen hundred ~~centuries~~, and hurled them from their usurped and illegitimate thrones; that extends her arms over the East and the West, preaching the same doctrine, employing the same language and conferring the same sacraments on the rich and the poor, the great and low, the *savant* and rustic alike; that now again buckles on her armor, fresh and vigorous as when Leo confronted Attila 1400 years ago, and calling her devoted sons around her, defies the socialistic ideas on the field of intellectual warfare and battles for the liberty of the individual, the integrity of the family and the existence of society.

To maintain that church in its financial honor, you Catholics of Newport have made a generous and warm response. Those who have paid one hundred dollars for the liquidation of the debt on St. Mary's, should, with gratitude, be remembered by the people of this parish, and moreover are now exempt from any future collection to pay the balance due on this church; their names, with those of the others who have not the same resources will appear on the following pages, to all of whom I present my personal gratitude and warm acknowledgments; and

for whom as their immediate pastor, my earnest prayers shall be raised to the Father, Son, and Holy Ghost, the three persons of the blessed Trinity, to whom be honor, praise, and glory forever.
