The season of Thanksgiving is upon us! The Board of the Museum of Newport Irish History would like to extend our gratitude to you, our members, for your generosity over the past year in support of our Mission of telling the rich story of the Irish in Newport County.

In 2024 and into the New Year, the museum is moving forward with exciting new initiatives. This summer, we received a \$15,000 grant from the Government of Ireland's Emigrant Support Programme. This grant will provide seed money to create a media display so visitors can explore Irish immigration in Newport County by accessing some of our archives in a storybook fashion. Earlier in the year, we received a RI Humanities Grant to expand access to our self-guided walking tours. Currently available only in printed leaflets, the Irish Newport neighborhood tours will be available as an app on a cell phone by downloading a QR code. With your support, we can complete these initiatives.
