PROFESSOR MATTHEWS RECEIVED HIS PhD FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF CONNECTICUT IN CLINCIAL PSYCHOLOGY AND HAS BEEN WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS, AMHERST FOR THE LAST 27 YEARS. DR. MATTHEWS HAS DUAL AMERICAN/IRISH CITIZENSHIP AND HAS STUDIED THE IRISH UPRISING AND CIVIL WARS FOR MANY YEARS. HE HAS PREVIOUSLY SPOKEN AT THE MUSEUM LECTURE SERIES REGARDING THE EASTER UPRISING, THE 1922-23 CIVIL WAR AND THE PEOPLE AND EVENTS SURRONDING THAT PERIOD.
